



AIMST UNIVERSITY Action Plan

Decision on Full Movement Control Order Imposed by the Malaysian Government from 1st June 2021 until 14th June 2021


1. As per the announcement by the Prime Minister on 28th May 2021, AIMST University shall remain closed from 1st June 2021 until 14th June 2021.
2. Student movement beyond the campus is restricted during this full lockdown period and movement inside the campus is to be limited.
3. The sports complex and swimming pool will remain closed during this period and also all sporting events and extra-curricular activities will not be allowed.
4. The library, study areas and other on-campus facilities are also not available during this period. However, laboratory (CLMU) will be open for research students in campus.
5. Students may continue to access learning resources required for their online studies. Essential support services will continue to operate and other services will be made online.
6. The following essential services will continue to operate. The services are:
 - a) Warden
 - b) Security
 - c) Cafeteria from 8 am to 8 pm (Only packed food to be eaten at your room)
 - d) Laundry
 - e) Division of Student Affairs
 - f) Clinic (Doctor and Nurse)
 - g) Cleaning services
 - h) Maintenance (Estates & Building)
 - i) IT Support
 - j) University services
 - k) Laboratory (CLMU) – staff on rotation
 - l) Finance Division – staff on rotation
 - m) Human Resource – staff on rotation
7. Academic staff will continue to work from home and conduct classes via on-line mode.
8. Non-academic staff (except for the above essential duties) are required to work from home.
(Note: HoD will outline the duties to be performed whilst undertaking home-based work).
9. Marketing team will continue working on-line and will be monitored by the HoD.
10. Limited access into campus
 - a) Access into AIMST campus would be restricted.
 - b) Essential service vendors entering through the main gate would be required to undergo health screening at the entrance.
 - c) Maids/helpers are not allowed to enter the campus during the lockdown period.

11. Student registration and new intake will be done on-line.
