# About AIMST University

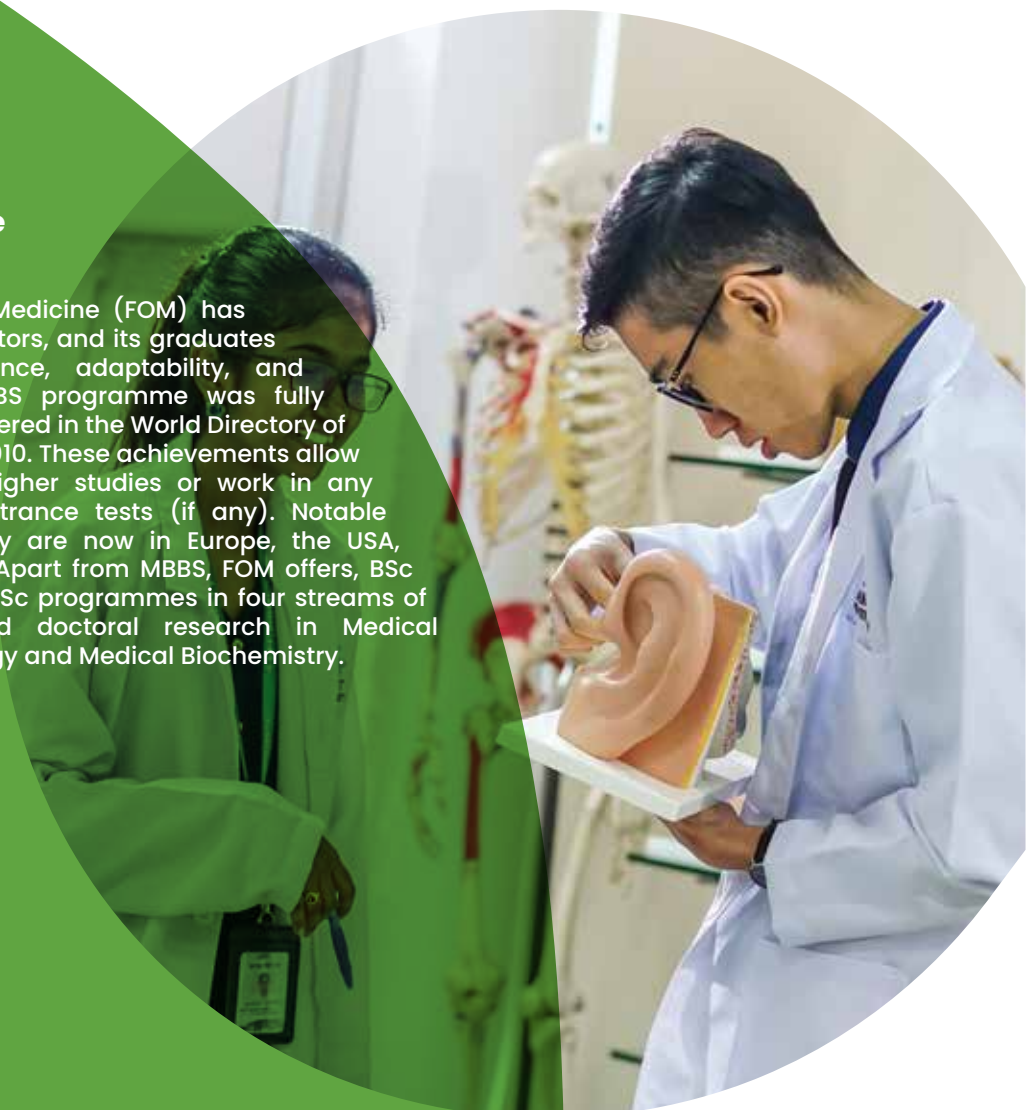

  - For international candidates pass IELTS with min band of 6.0 or TOEFL with min 550 paper-based or equivalents
  - SPM /O- levels requirement : Applicants must have obtained (5Bs each in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics (or Additional Mathematics) and another subject.
  - Malaysian applicants who seek employment in the public sector are required to attain credit in Bahasa Malaysia & English

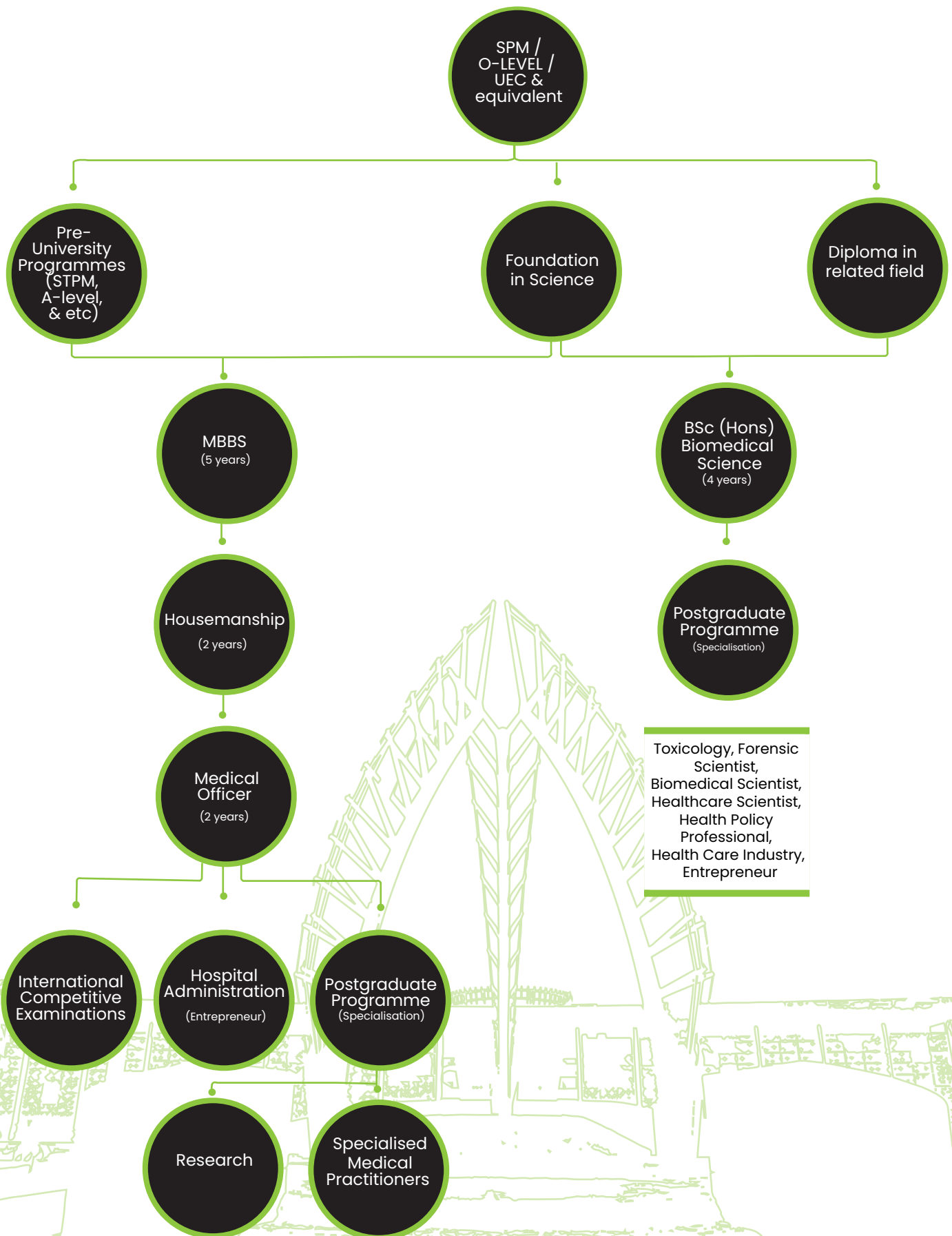

- A-Level or equivalent
- Pass with minimum Grade D in TWO of the following subjects (Biology, Physics/Mathematics and Chemistry)
- **Recognised Diploma**
- Pass with minimum CGPA of 2.75 in related field
- Recognised Diploma with CGPA less than 2.75 in related field  
and a minimum of 3 years (36 months) working experience in the related field.
- **Other qualifications**
- Will be assessed and referred for approval on case by case basis
- For malaysian students MUET minimum Band 3 needed upon entry.
- For international students IELTS 5.5/ TOFEL 550 needed upon entry.

- A bachelor's degree in the field or related fields or equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 and not meeting CGPA of 2.75, can be accepted subject to rigorous internal assessment; or
- A bachelor's degree in the field or related fields or equivalent with minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting CGPA of 2.50, can be accepted subject to a minimum of 5 years working experience in the relevant field and rigorous internal assessment.  
-Candidates without a qualification in the related fields or relevant working experience must undergo appropriate prerequisite courses determined by the HEP and meet the minimum CGPA based on (i) to (iii).

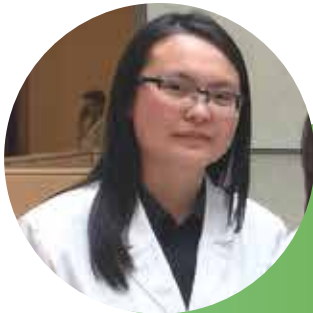
