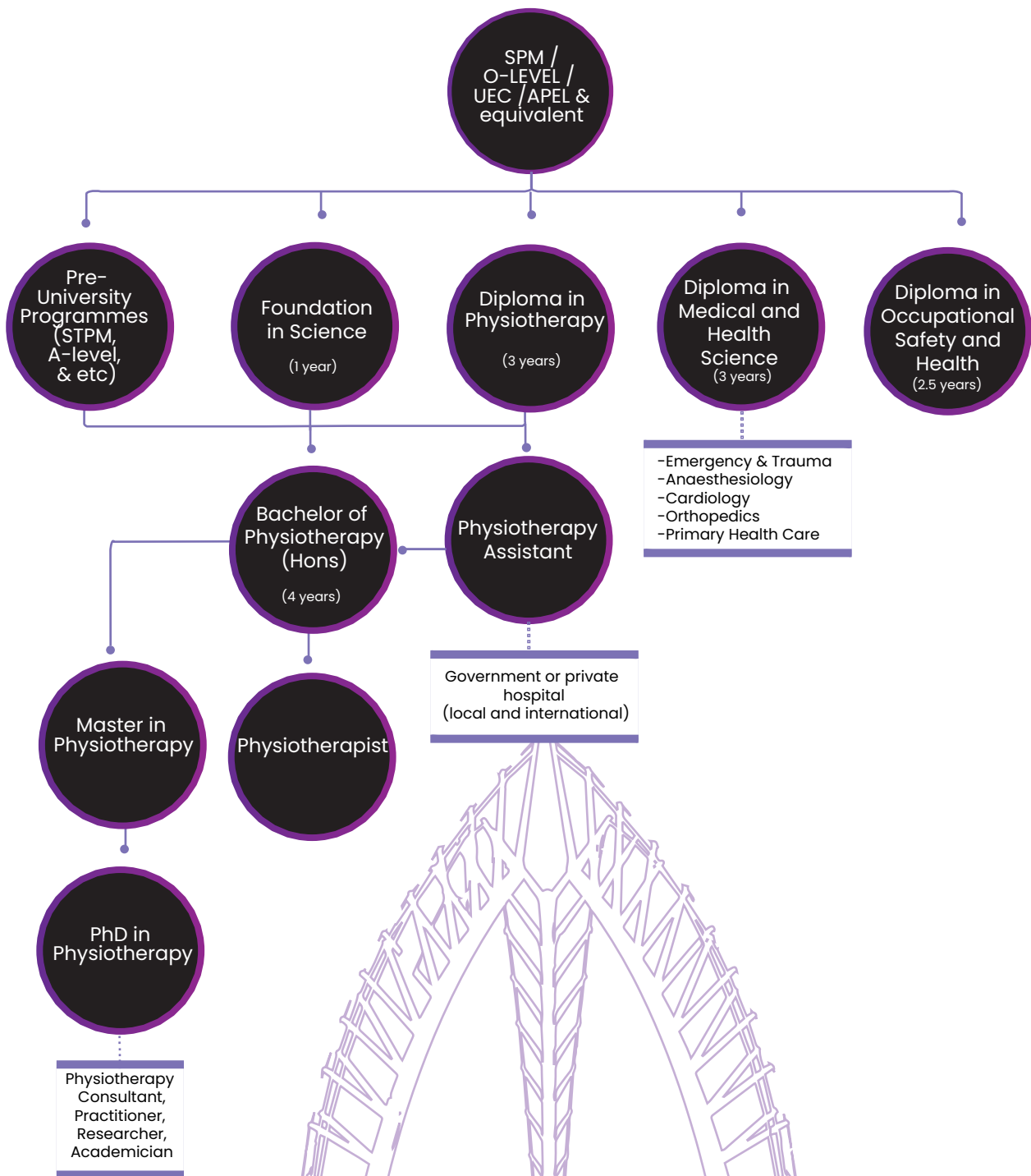

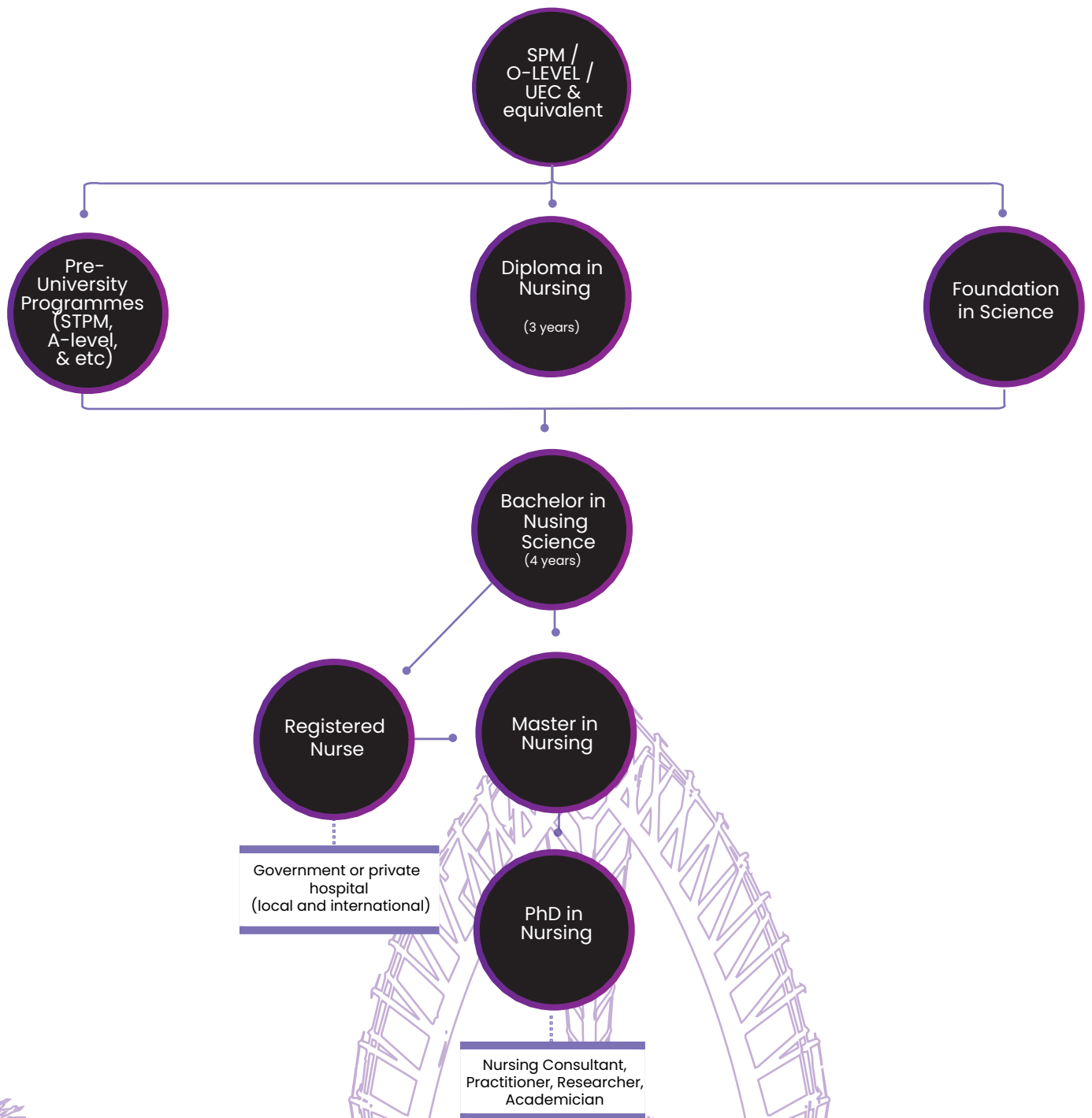
◆ Entry Requirement
